



Lifting of Restrictions Plan Phase 1

Effective **7/1/2020** , until further notice.

While Governor Reynolds has opened much of Iowa's businesses, she continues to instruct vulnerable individuals to continue to self-isolate. In consideration of the health and safety of the vulnerable population served by Skyline Center, Inc., and our employees, Skyline has developed the following guidelines:

Visitors:

- All individuals will have the ability to have limited visitation.
- All Visitors are screened upon arrival.
- Visitors unable to pass the screening or comply with infection control practices like masks will refrain from visiting.
- Visitation shall occur only during scheduled visitation hours or by appointment for emergencies.
- Visits shall occur outdoors to ensure social distancing, proper hand hygiene, universal source control, and overall supervision of safe practices related to visitors.
- Skyline Center will determine their capacity to manage limited visits.

Indoor visits will be limited to compassionate care situations to include end-of-life and those individuals with significant changes in medical condition.

Activities:

- Outdoor activities must allow for proper social distancing, use of hand sanitizer and masks.
- If during the outdoor activity social distancing is unable to be maintained, the activity must end, and participants will return home.
- Examples of activities that are NOT allowed at this time
 - Eating at a restaurant
 - Attending a movie at a movie theater
 - Bowling
 - Malls
 - Social gatherings in homes, apartments
 - Playgrounds
 - Swimming pools
 - Farmer's Market

Intermittent Services:

- Activities for intermittent essential services will be provided following proper social distancing, use of hand sanitizer and masks.
- If at any time these guidelines are unable to be maintained, the activity must end, and participants will return home.

Phased Regression:

- Skyline will continue to monitor for the presence of COVID-19. This will occur through daily screening of individuals served and employees before and after each shift and assessing the level of community virus activity via the Iowa Coronavirus website.
- Skyline will remain in Phase 1 of reopening until further notice; OR until the Pandemic has been lifted; OR until a pattern (2 or more) of individuals served or employees are confirmed positive for COVID-19, at which time, Skyline will return to a no visitor restriction until 14 days have passed with no additional individuals served or employees testing positive for COVID-19.
